# Lesson plan

<u>Topic:</u> Academic Vocabulary revision & consolidation <u>Vocabulary:</u> AWL Sublists 1-10 <u>Grammar:</u> corresponding prepositions with nouns, verbs, adjectives

This is a game for students to practise their understanding and knowledge of corresponding prepositions. The idea is that they try to get 4-in-a-row to win a point.

## Procedure

- 1. Divide class into groups of fours
- 2. Give out one copy of the word grid to each group and 1 student the answers
- *3.* Give an example on the board: *founded* \_\_\_\_\_ (*by/in*) / *compiled* \_\_\_\_ (*by*)/
- 4. Students take it in turns to guess one preposition and the answer is checked by the student with the answers who only says '*yes or no*' (if '*no*' they don't tell the answer so another student can try)
- 5. If a correct answer is said, the student colours that square, and tries to get 4-ina-row.
- 6. HARDER: students guess the preposition and then verbally make a sentence.

## Important:

No order - they can choose any word anywhere in the grid. Try to discourage *to+infinitive* forms.
