1.Lead in

- Ask Students to discuss the 'title' and predict the content of lecture
- Ask students to write down key terms / language from discussion
- Feed in / check key vocabulary

Three types of lesson

Lesson#1: [hard]

- 1. Students listen once take notes.
- 2. Give 5 minutes to tidy notes.
- 3. Listen again and add to notes (use a different colour pen).
- 4. Give out questions set <u>20-25 minutes</u> to answer.
- 5. Feedback answers (give out answers or go through on board).

Lesson #2: [medium]

- 1. Students listen once take notes.
- 2. Give out questions: Set <u>15 minutes</u> for students to answer questions from notes.
- 3. Listen again students answer the missed questions as they listen.
- 4. Give extra 10 minutes to consolidate answers.
- 5. Feedback answers (give out answers or go through on board).

Lesson #3: [easy]

- 1. Give out questions students have 10 minutes to look at questions.
- 2. Students listen and answer questions.
- 3. Give 5 minutes to tidy answers.
- 4. Students listen again check answers and answer missed questions.
- 5. 5-10 minutes to tidy answers.
- 6. Feedback answers (give out answers or go through on board).

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Hello and welcome today's lecture entitled Academic plagiarism: the use of custom essay writing services. I'll begin with defining plagiarism and its evolution, followed by what are custom essay writing services and why students use them. Then I'll identify the key problems associated with using such services and finally offer some possible solutions.

So let's begin with plagiarism. Plagiarism at university is a form of cheating and is a serious academic offence. It arises from work submitted that is not the student's own and has been taken from another source usually including lack of referencing, poor paraphrasing or completely copied. The most common forms of plagiarism are: copying, collusion, fabrication or misrepresentation, unacceptable proofreading and commissioning work / buying essays. The focus of this lecture is on commissioning work and/or buying essays.
