

Description, Analysis and Evaluation EXAMPLE

<u>Aim</u>: To support students in their understanding of how description, analysis and evaluation are used in academic writing.

Time: 90 minutes & homework task.

<u>Delivery:</u> This lesson can be delivered face-to-face or online. For online delivery, each worksheet could be placed in a class document on OneDrive.

Lead in

- Distribute worksheet 1. Students complete task 1: compare the two paragraphs.
- Feedback: nominate a student to answer.
- Students complete tasks 2&3: definitions of key terms and identifying language.
- Feedback¹: distribute or project worksheet 1 tasks 2&3 ANSWERS.
- Feedback²: distribute or project the **writing criteria** for your course if you have one. Point out where analysis and evaluation are assessed (Task?).

Language Review

Distribute the language review. Students read and ask questions if clarity is needed.

Guided Practice

- Distribute worksheet 2. Students complete tasks 1&2: sentence level analysis and gap fill.
- Feedback: distribute, project or go through worksheet 2 tasks 1&2 ANSWERS.
- Distribute worksheet 3.
- Students complete tasks 1-3 individually or in pairs.
- Feedback: distribute or project worksheet 3 tasks 1-3 ANSWERS.
- Distribute worksheet 4. Look at example together as a class.
- Students complete tasks 1-6 individually or in pairs.
- Feedback: distribute, project or go through worksheet 4 tasks 1-6 ANSWERS.

Freer Practice

- Distribute worksheet 5. Students complete task 1: writing a paragraph.
- Feedback¹: students use the peer feedback form to check their partner's work (Task 2).
- Feedback²: Students compare their paragraphs (Task 3) with the SUGGESTED ANSWER.

Homework

- Worksheet 6 task 1: students select, research and choose an article related to their studies.
 They read through and highlight language connected to description, analysis and evaluation.
 They then copy the new phrases into their vocabulary books.




Fig. 1. Online payment methods in the UK in 2019 (adapted from Statistica, 2021).




Fig. 2. The perception of the benefits of voice banking in the US (adapted from insider intelligence, 2021).
