

Medical Academic Word List: An Introduction

Suggested Lesson Plan

Aim: To introduce & develop the students' awareness and lexical repertoire of the Medical Academic Word List (MAWL).

1. Introduction

• Distribute/display the MAWL (at the back of this book) and explain the rationale behind it.

Rationale

- ⇒ The MAWL contains 623 non-subject specific and medical words which were selected because they appear with great frequency in a broad range of medical research articles.
- \Rightarrow There are over 3000 words because each word has a number of word forms. Example: $cell^{(n)}/cells^{(n)}/cellulose^{(n)}/cellulate^{(v)}/cellular^{(adj)}/cellular^{(adj)}$
- ⇒ There are 10 sublists separated in terms of frequency with sublist 1 being the most frequent.
- ⇒ The list helps identify academic vocabulary and medical terminology.
